The program explores Lafayette’s US-French connections, the principal people and places of his career. Highlights of the talk include landmarks along the route of Lafayette’s crusade for liberty in the American and French Revolutions and his early stand for abolition. Visits to many historic American landmarks and patriots’ homes document his itinerary as the Nation’s Guest in 1824. Notable monuments, an epic 1961 film and the re-creation of his 1780 ship Hermione commemorate significant events of Lafayette’s exemplary life.
